WHEREAS

- (A) On 30 May 2018 Elsevier and Lead Institution entered into a Elsevier Subscription Agreement regarding the licensed materials defined in Annexes of this Agreement (the "**Agreement**"); Agreement was published in the Register of Contracts on 10 December 2018 with the ID of contract 7019275; and
- (B) The Parties wish to correct certain errors that occurred in Schedule I of the Agreement related to Science Direct ®.

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the Agreement, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

1. REVISIONS

By signing of this Amendment, the Parties expressly and irrevocably agree to modify the Agreement as follows.

- 1.1 In Schedule 1.1 Subscribed Products/Access/Fees of the Agreement in the table related to Science Direct ® the Parties agree to change and replace the current lines ECR-55049 National Technical Library) and ECR-55047 University of Chemistry and Technology Prague with the following lines:

1.2 The other provisions of the Agreement shall remain unchanged.

2. MISCELLANEOUS

2.1 Regarding the law governing the Amendment and the resolution of any dispute which may arise from it, the Parties have agreed that the corresponding provisions of the Agreement shall apply by analogy.

2.2 The Amendment shall be binding upon, and inure to the benefit of, the Parties and their respective legal successors and assigns.

2.3 This Amendment shall become valid upon being signed by both Parties. The Amendment shall become effective on the date of its publication in the Register of Contracts in accordance with the conditions laid down by Act No. 340/2015 Coll., On the Register of Contracts. The Amendment will be in this register published by the Lead Institution.

2.4 No changes, alterations or modifications hereto shall be effective unless made in writing and signed by the Parties.

2.5 The Amendment has been executed in three (3) original counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original. Elsevier shall receive one counterpart and the Lead Institution shall receive two counterparts.
