

**Addendum to the Memorandum of Understanding
for the establishment and operation of the
Sponsoring Consortium for Open Access Publishing in Particle Physics (SCOAP³)
covering the SCOAP³ for Books initiative**

between

THE EUROPEAN ORGANIZATION FOR NUCLEAR RESEARCH (“CERN”), an Intergovernmental Organization with its seat at Geneva, Switzerland, as the Host Organization of SCOAP³ and SCOAP³ Partner, represented by its Director-General, Fabiola Gianotti,

and

THE NATIONAL LIBRARY OF TECHNOLOGY, a State Contribution Organization set up by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports, with its principal offices at Technická 6, 160 80 Praha 6 – Dejvice, identification number: 61387142 (the “Representative”), represented by Martin Svoboda

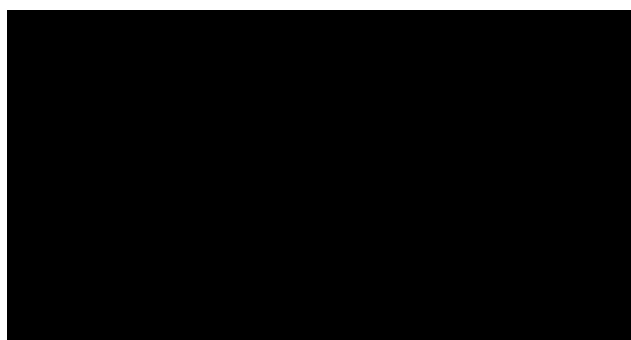
1. The Representative shall collect all confirmed voluntary contributions from SCOAP³ Partners in Czech Republic to the SCOAP³ for Books initiative and shall transfer the collected amounts to CERN.
2. The Representative has informed CERN that the confirmed amount payable by the Representative into the SCOAP³ Fund to cover the costs of the services provided by Publishers to the SCOAP³ for Books initiative, pilot project shall be 14,420.00 Euros.
3. This amount shall be paid end of June 2024.
4. The Representative has informed CERN that he will charge the amount payable (§ 2) to the SCOAP³ for Books initiative Partners as listed in § 6.

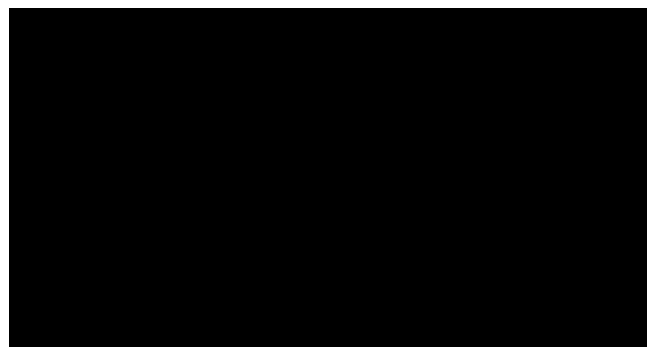
