What is a Read & Publish agreement?

Elsevier has partnered with academic institutions and consortia around the world to support authors who wish to publish open access: <https://www.elsevier.com/open-access/agreements>.

Under a Read and Publish agreement, the cost of publishing open access is covered. Eligible corresponding authors do not have to pay an article publishing charge or APC.

Definition

Submitting corresponding author

- Submitting corresponding author is the author who submits the article to Elsevier and stays in contact with Elsevier in the end-to-end journey
- This is the author who makes the publishing choice on behalf of the author group. Every article has one corresponding author.
- For the purposes of eligibility under the agreement, there can only be one corresponding author. The corresponding author is the author who submits the manuscript and other documentation to the journal and is the primary contact between the journal and the co-authors. Importantly, the corresponding author's affiliation will be used to determine eligibility for the publishing agreement.
- The affiliations of other co-authors are not relevant for agreement eligibility.
- Journals may follow requests of the team of authors and display other corresponding authors in the published article. Which corresponding authors are displayed on the published paper, however, is not relevant for agreement eligibility.

Acceptance Date

This is the date the journal accepts the article for publication

Elsevier OA Platform

Elsevier OA Platform (EOAP) is a user-friendly interface where we present the institutional administrators with the open access articles eligible for the agreement.

Administrators at the institution validate the eligibility of the author for an OA agreement

Eligibility criteria

Eligibility component	Description
Acceptance date	The acceptance date of the article should fall within the period of agreement for your institution
Author affiliation	The submitting corresponding author must be affiliated with a participating institution in the agreement. Your affiliation must be validated by the institution
Journal title	The article must be submitted to and accepted in a participating journal.
APC available	Institution has APCs for the year
Article types	Article types that offer OA (Next slide shows the list of article types that offer OA by default)

Article type descriptions

PIT Codes	Article Type	Description
CRP	Case Report	A detailed report of the symptoms, diagnosis, treatment and follow-up of an individual patient.
DAT	Data in Brief	A short article that presents research data.
FLA	Full-length Article	A detailed study of original research.
MIC	Microarticle	A short publication; typically a brief description of original research.
OSP	Original Software Publication	An article that comprises computer code or software and a description thereof.
PRO	Protocol	A written procedure or guideline that provides a methodology for undertaking a specific piece of research.
REV	Review Article	An article that summarizes and reviews the current state of understanding of a topic.
RPL	Replication Study	An article that presents results of the replication of research performed previously and published elsewhere.
SCO	Short Communication	A short report or announcement of research, usually claiming certain results. (may appear under many names, e.g. Letter Papers, Preliminary Notes, Notes, etc)
SSU	Short Survey	A short or mini Review Article, summarizing the current state of understanding of a topic.
VID	Video Article	An article that primarily consists of a video and a description of the content therein.
